This is a Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, 1950 seeking direction against Respondents Nos. 2 to 4 to regularize the Petitioners into permanent employment as Post Graduate Teachers at Jamia Girls Senior Secondary School in view of the continuous, uninterrupted and unblemished service since the academic year 2008-09 with all consequential benefits.
4. Issue Notice. Mr. Pritish Sabharwal, learned Counsel for Respondent Nos. 1 to 3 accepts Notice and seeks time to file Reply.
5. Let Notice be served on Respondent Nos. 4 and 5 through all permissible modes upon taking steps, returnable on 10.08.2024.
6. Learned Counsel for Respondent Nos. 1 to 3 submits that there is no notification on record, whereby there is any likelihood of termination of



services of the Petitioners. He further submits that Petitioners have preferred the present Petition only on an apprehension that their services would be terminated while there is no termination in contemplation of the Petitioners at this stage.

7. The said statement is taken on record.
8. Let Reply be filed within a period of four weeks from today. Rejoinder thereto, if any, be filed within a period of two weeks thereafter.
